The candidate will need to submit the following documents: a CV and a proposal explaining how you plan to conduct the tasks, an outline, a proposed methodology, a work plan & budget (not more than 2 pages).

The contract will be awarded to the candidate whose offer represents the best value for money, taking into account the quality of submitted document and individual expertise.

The estimated price will be max. 6000 EUR, all taxes included. Payment will be made on receipt and approval of the final report. The Contract will be drawn up between EASPD and the contractee.
